



## DIRECTIONS

**This is one of the oldest and simplest optical devices for viewing a solar eclipse!**

1. Use a thumb tack to poke a tiny hole in the shaded center of the "P"
2. Stand with the sun at your back and hold this paper face up so that it not blocked by your shadow.
3. The light can be projected on the ground or another piece of paper to safely view an image of the eclipse.
4. Remember - DO NOT look directly at the sun. Enjoy!
